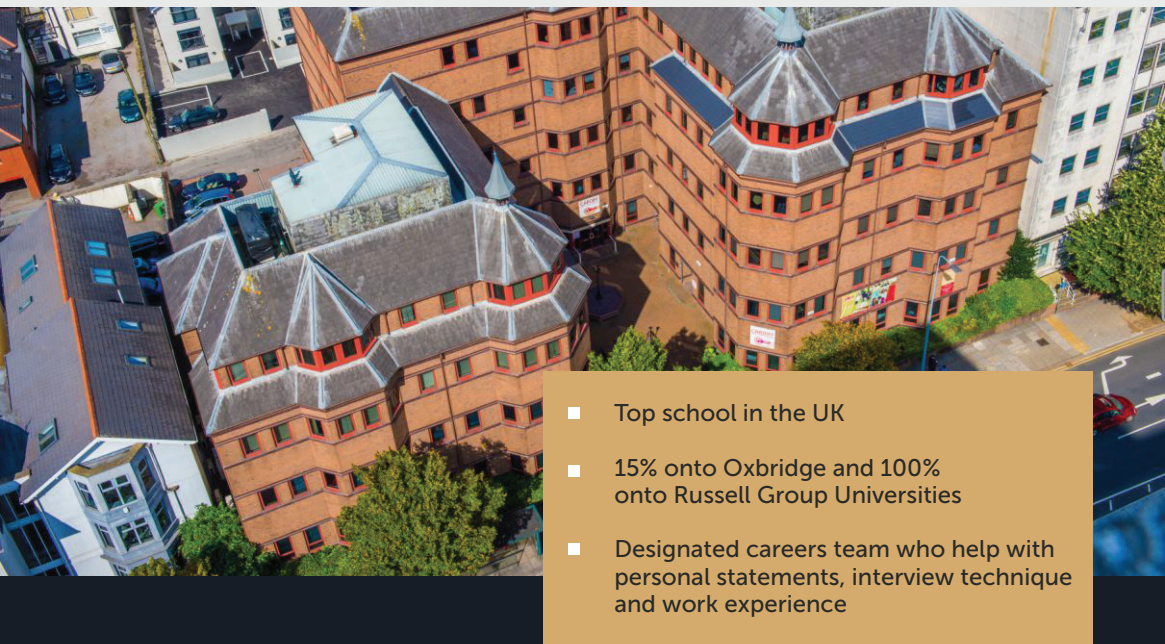

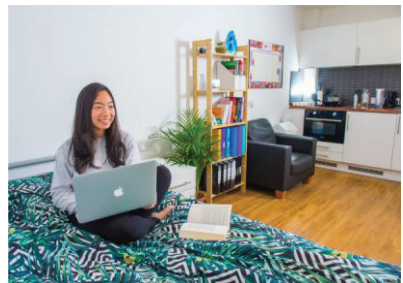

Earlscliffe is a 'boutique' day and boarding school in Folkestone, Kent, on the British heritage coast. The school has gained an international reputation for its 'gold-standard' A-level programme and the quality of its university pathways provision. Alongside its traditional two-year A-level programme, Earlscliffe offers an International Transition Year (ITY), a Foundation Year, and a Diploma in Business Management.

In its recent Ofsted inspection in June 2017, Earlscliffe was rated 'Outstanding' in all six areas.

Earlscliffe enrolls students aged 15 to 19 from all nationalities. The school provides a personalised education experience in a family-style environment, where class sizes are kept to an average of eight students and the total number of students at around 100. Staff at Earlscliffe draw on teaching methods inspired by Oxbridge colleges, top schools, and other world-leading universities.

We provide five boarding houses, two for girls and two for boys, all within easy walking distance of the main college. Most rooms are spacious twins with private WC and bathroom; each student has his or her own wardrobe and desk space, and all rooms are Wi-fi connected. The high standard of accommodation is attractive to today's student, and all the more so given Earlscliffe's beautiful Victorian façade. The classrooms and laboratory were also renovated and newly-equipped so that they provide a fresh, bright, yet intimate environment in which our students and staff go about their daily business. Our houses and buildings are all cleaned daily and students laundry is done twice per week.

We have a central dining room with kitchens which provides 3 home-cooked meals per day and providing a variety of food options including vegan and vegetarian.

Students play football, basketball, volleyball, squash, badminton and table tennis with one another each week. In the summer months, we also offer tennis and golf. The football team plays in a competitive league. There is also a gym and large indoor pool nearby, to which our students have free access.

All sports facilities are within walking distance, except for golf, which is a short drive away at Etchinghill Golf Club. Some of England's greatest golf courses are on the Kent coast, including Royal St George's at Sandwich, a regular British Open venue.
